

This activity is designed for learners of Spanish who want to practise the future tense using the song “No Seré” by Julieta Venegas. Even if your goal is to learn Spanish future verbs, mixing tenses and working with songs helps build overall tense awareness. Below you’ll find a cloze exercise where future-tense verbs have been removed. Fill the blanks using the verbs from the word bank, then check your answers in the completed version.

## How to use this exercise

- **First**, read each line and identify the intended meaning to choose the correct infinitive from the word bank.
- **Then**, conjugate the infinitive in the future tense for yo: for regular verbs, add the future endings (-é, -ás, -á, -emos, -éis, -án) to the infinitive (for example, ser → seré).
- **Finally**, say the completed lines out loud to practise pronunciation and rhythm.

## Note

If you also want to learn Spanish preterite tense verbs, try creating a similar cloze activity that removes those verbs instead. Comparing both exercises helps improve your grasp of when to use future versus preterite forms.
