

¡Hola! Here's a fun activity to learn to talk about family and make questions in Spanish.

Objective

Students practice family vocabulary and closed questions (yes/no questions) by guessing which family member their partner has chosen.

1. Materials

- A printable **family tree** with portraits or icons for each family member.
- A **character card list** (one per student) with all family members' names.
- Optional: **individual cards** for each family member to draw randomly.

2. Sample Family Tree (Large, 16 People)

Abuelos (grandparents)

- Abuelo Juan
- Abuela Carmen
- Abuelo Miguel
- Abuela Rosa

Parents + Aunts/Uncles

- Papá Carlos
- Mamá Elena
- Tío José
- Tía Marta
- Tío Luis
- Tía Ana

Children + Cousins

- Hijo Pedro
- Hija Lucía
- Primo Diego
- Prima Sofía
- Primo Javier

- Prima María

3. Closed Question Bank

Students may only ask **yes/no questions** in Spanish. Examples:

About gender/age:

- ¿Es hombre? / ¿Es mujer?
- ¿Es adulto? / ¿Es niño o niña?

About family role:

- ¿Es abuelo/a?
- ¿Es parente o madre?
- ¿Es tío o tía?
- ¿Es primo/a?
- ¿Es hijo o hija?

About relationships:

- ¿Es el parente de Pedro?
- ¿Es la hermana de Diego?
- ¿Es el hijo de Carlos?

4. How to Play

1. Each pair of students gets the **same family tree**.
2. Each secretly chooses **one family member** (or draws a card).
3. Taking turns, they ask **yes/no questions** in Spanish to eliminate people.
 - Example: “¿Es una mujer?” → If “sí,” they eliminate all men.
4. First student to guess correctly wins the round.

5. Variations

- **Level 1 (Novice):** Only allow simple questions (Es hombre/mujer, es adulto/niño, es abuelo/tía/etc.).
- **Level 2 (Intermediate):** Add relationship-based questions (Is this person

Pedro's father? Is she Sofía's cousin?).

- **Fast Play:** Instead of eliminating, students can take turns guessing after each question.

Guess Who? Family Portrait Game Board (Spanish)

Features

- **16 family members** arranged in a tree (grandparents at top → parents/aunts/uncles → children/cousins).
- Each portrait has a simple icon (male/female, adult/child) + name in Spanish.
- Designed so students can cover/eliminate people as they ask questions.

How Students Use It

- Each student has **the same game board**.
- They secretly choose **one family member**.
- They ask yes/no questions in Spanish to eliminate portraits.
- Students cover portraits with coins, post-its, or by crossing out.
