

Spanish Irregular Verb Conjugation Maze Game (Present Tense)

Objective

Move from START to FINISH by correctly conjugating irregular verbs in the present tense.

How to Play

1. Begin at the START space.
2. You may move up, down, left, or right—only if you correctly conjugate the verb in that space.
3. Each space includes a subject pronoun and a common irregular verb in the infinitive.
4. Say or write the correct present-tense form before moving.
5. The first player to reach FINISH wins.

- Combine this with -AR/-ER/-IR or stem-changing verb mazes for a station rotation.
